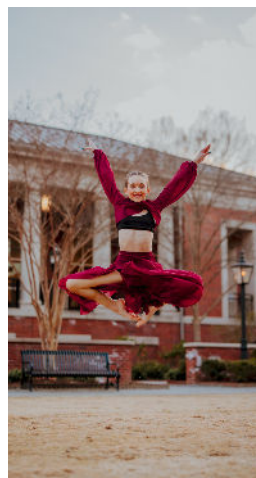

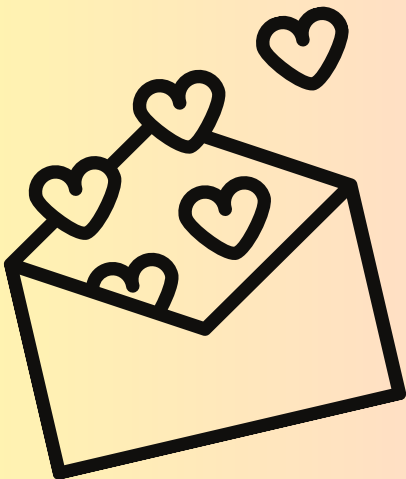

Recital Details are coming in your inbox soon.

Here's an overview:

Monday May 18th is dress rehearsal.

Each class has a 10 minute time-slot on stage to practice their dance.

There are 4 recital shows: two on May 19th & two on May 20th.

Each class is assigned 1 show. Shows are 45 minutes long.

Your classes specific days/times will be in your recital packet.

Duet Dance: Be Part of the Tradition

What is it? Duet Dance is an extra dance performed at the end of each recital. ADC dancers choose a non-dancer to perform with them, e.g. Dad, Mom, Brother, Cousin, etc.

Why Should I Participate? It's a fun way to get involved with ADC and share your dancer's passion. There is no "appropriate" age - we have 3 year olds all the way through graduating seniors who participate.

How big of a commitment is this? There are 4 30-minute rehearsals to learn the dance. Participation at all the rehearsals is not required. Each rehearsal is filmed so you can review at home. Duet Partners can watch the recital and will be told to come back stage to prepare for Duet Dance.
